COVID-19 Health & Safety Protocols (as of January 1, 2022)

Rybicki Tours, LLC is committed to keeping our staff and customers as safe as possible. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. Rybicki Tours has taken enhanced health and safety measures for you, our other travelers, and our employees. - 1) Temporary COVID-19 Vaccine Policy- All travelers must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 to travel with Rybicki Tours. Please be prepared to show proof of vaccination upon boarding the motorcoach the morning of your tour departure. If you do not have your vaccination card or copy of your vaccination card to show, you will not be permitted to travel on tour.
- **2) Per CDC recommendation** masks must be worn by all travelers and staff whenever the group is on the motorcoach- unless you are eating or drinking. Masks with ventilators, neck gaiters or bandanas are not acceptable.
- **3) Overnight Adventures** Assigned seating on the motorcoach will be implemented by Rybicki Tours. While our goal is for solo travelers to be assigned a row to themselves, it is not guaranteed. Double occupancy travelers will be expected to sit together. Single occupancy travelers traveling with friends may request to sit together (please indicate request ASAP).
- **4)** By boarding the motorcoach the morning of tour departure, you are confirming that you can confidently answer "no" to all screening questions below. If you can answer "yes" to any screening questions below, you will not be permitted to travel on tour.
- 5) The Tour Manager or Driver will frequently wipe down common high-touch surfaces on the motorcoach for your protection.
- **6)** While hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes and masks will be provided on tour, it is also encouraged that customers bring their own.
